<p>Professional Development - Staff and Board – Read Family Literacy Training for staff, board governance training and Leadership Training. Training will help us to continue helping local adults to develop essential Literacy skills.</p>	
Enderby and District Community Resource Centre**	\$10,000
<p>Outreach Worker/Community Support Program provides direct support to families in the community, offering intense parenting support, referrals, crisis intervention, short-term counseling, and life skills. Funds seek to expand the current work arrangement with additional hours for program facilitator.</p>	
Kingfisher Interpretive Centre**	\$10,000
<p>Conservation Through Education provides an opportunity for local children (grades K-12) to educate and focus on our local environmental sustainability, ecosystem support and salmon lifecycle.</p>

<p>2022-2023 School Assembly Program, MADD Canada developed the School Assembly Program to teach youth in grades 7-12 new skills and information including the consequences of impaired driving, alternatives to driving impaired and to plan ahead and call 911 if they see a suspected impaired driver. In 2021-2022 approximately 1,000,000 students will see the presentation at 9 schools in the Valley First region including Armstrong, Lumby, Oliver, Penticton, Princeton, Vernon, Kamloops, and Kelowna.</p>
